1. Click on the “ask a question” button

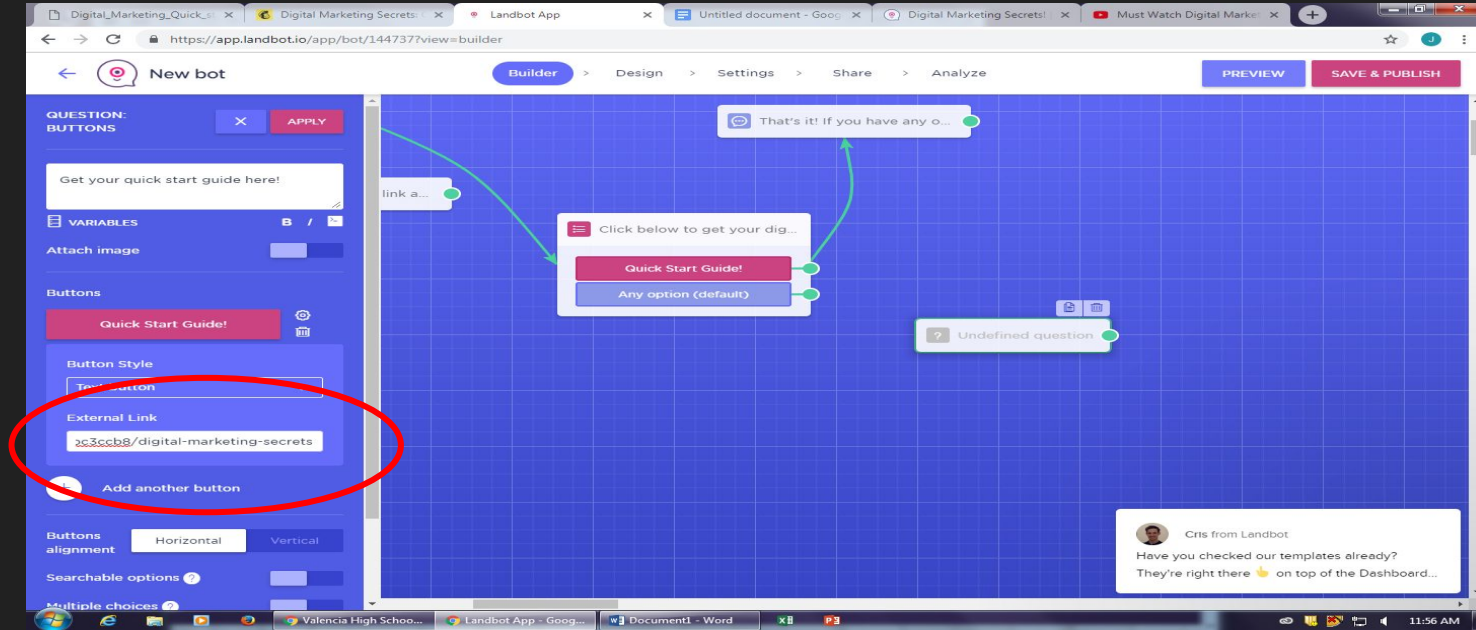

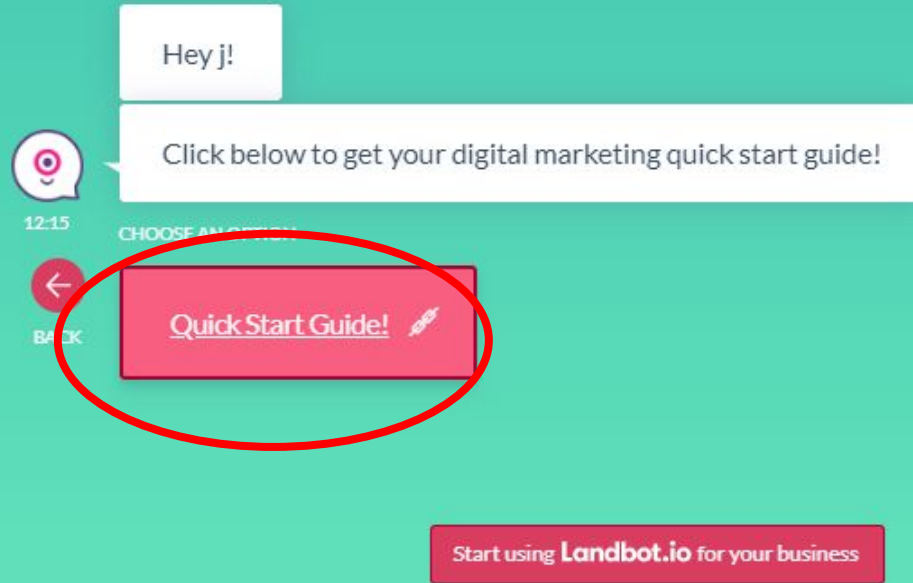
4. Click on “Setting symbol” button on the right of Quick Start Guide
